

SANE Advocate Job Description

Job Type: Contract

Work Location: In-Person

Pay: \$200-\$1,000 per month

Hours: Contracted on-call position. A minimum commitment of 8 twelve-hour shift per month, with some weekend and holiday coverage. One evening staff meeting per month.

Purpose of a SANE: The Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner (SANE) advocate will provide timely, non-judgmental, compassionate care to the sexual assault victim. The SANE exam may include a medical-forensic exam, prophylaxis for pregnancy and sexually transmitted infections, photographic documentation, and referrals for appropriate medical and psychological follow-up. The advocate will provide support, resources, and referrals during the exam.

SANE Advocate Qualifications and Requirements:

- CPR or BLS certified *within 6 months of hire
- Minimum two years working in nonprofit settings with vulnerable populations
- Successful completion of New Entry Training and program specific training
- Provide support and document sexual assault medical forensic exam advocacy accurately and timely
- Provide advocacy during a medical forensic evaluation to include: emotional support, safety planning, education about Crime Victims Compensation, coordinating referrals for appropriate follow-up care as needed
- 96 hours minimum coverage of on-call per month, to include shared holiday coverage
- Recommended minimum of five adult exams providing advocacy within 12 month period, with completion of continued education, case studies, literature review, and chart reviews
- Participate in periodic case review to include documentation
- Attend minimum of 8 of the offered 12 annual staff meetings and/or participate in multidisciplinary team meetings
- Active email, and cell phone/text/app access for routine staff wide interface and communication
- Proof of Hepatitis B, MMR, and annual Flu vaccinations. Proof of negative TB status.
