Preparation: Must hold a Registered Nurse license in the state of Michigan. Must have a minimum of three years of experience in nursing. Must be SANE certified or willing to become SANE certified. Knowledge of community resources and of philosophical and legal issues of domestic violence/sexual assault is desirable.

Job Summary: Coordinates all aspects of the agency's Sexual Assault Examiner (SANE) program for adults and teens. Provides SANE exams and coordinates, schedules, and trains on-call nurses, ensuring 24/7 nurse coverage. Provides expert testimony in court for sexual assault cases and outreach and training to community partners. In conjunction with other staff, advocates for systems change and the needs of sexual assault survivors.
