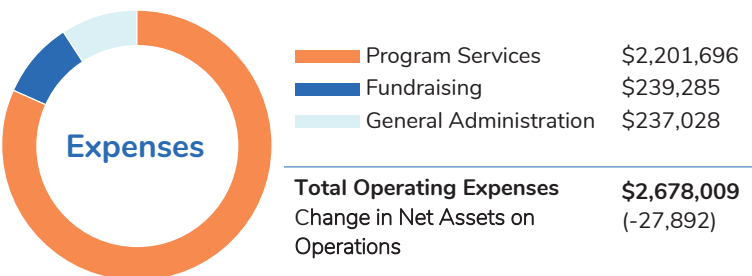
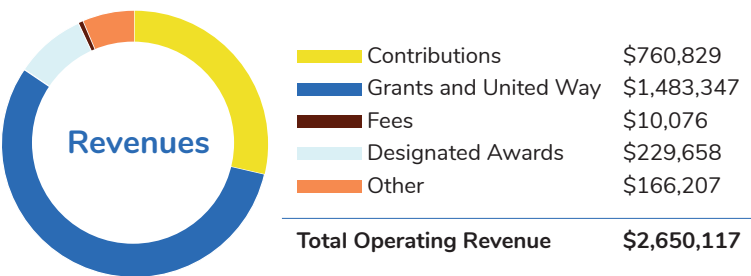
Fiscal Year 2021 Community Report

Did you know?

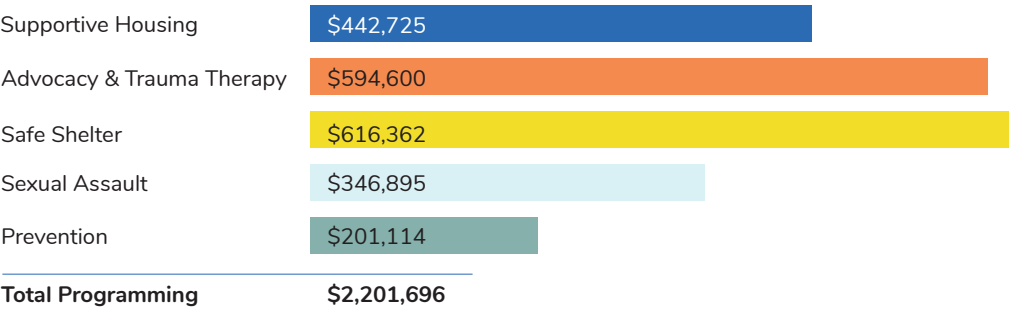
- + Throughout the pandemic, we utilized alternative locations for safe shelter for survivors at risk of imminent harm or lethality.
- + Survivors and their children are staying in our emergency shelter longer, an average of 7 weeks, due to the lack of affordable housing in our community.
- + Our Supportive Housing program has grown by 25% over the last three years, providing more than 24,000 nights of safe housing last year in addition to our emergency shelter.
- + The number of children engaged in therapy in 2021 decreased, but is now on the rise as we can host in-person sessions once again.
