Preparation: Requires a master's degree, with licensure to provide clinical therapeutic intervention in the state of Michigan. Three to five years of experience in direct individual and group services for clients. Experience in trauma therapy or related areas. Knowledge of community resources and of philosophical and legal issues of domestic violence/sexual assault. Demonstrates a commitment to equity, diversity, inclusion, and self-learning. Understands and supports the philosophy of empowerment.

Job Summary: Responsible for coordinating all aspects of the agency's trauma therapy program. Provides direct supervision to trauma therapy program staff, interns, and volunteers. Provides individual and group therapy services to adult victims of sexual assault and domestic violence, and children who have been exposed to domestic violence.

Key leadership position responsible for the oversight and implementation of trauma therapy programs for adults and children based on client and community needs, grant requirements and agency expectations. Provides support, mentoring, development, and supervision for trauma therapy team. Works closely with direct service supervisors to assure quality of service delivery across programs. Develops cooperative and collaborative relationships with relevant external organizations and systems.
