Understands and supports the philosophy of empowerment. Ability to solve problems independently and work as a team. Bilingual English/Spanish highly desired.

Job Summary: Provides trauma-informed crisis intervention, advocacy, and education for sexual assault survivors. Both during and outside of business hours, responds to the advocacy needs of persons requesting sexual assault forensic exams. Carries cell phone at all times and responds to all calls in a timely manner. Takes the lead on outreach opportunities that further expand the visibility of the agency's services for sexual assault survivors.
