

The Power of Prevention

The Lakeshore Alliance Against Domestic and Sexual Violence (LAADSV) will award a total of \$2,000 to non-profit organizations doing work to prevent domestic and sexual violence in our community.

In 2013, LAADSV members voted to invest in domestic and sexual violence prevention through awards to organizations in Ottawa County. Each year, the Executive Committee will determine the amount to be awarded. The Executive Committee elected to award up to \$2,000 in 2024 to one or more organizations. Award applications will be reviewed by the LAADSV Executive Committee and selected by a majority vote.

Eligibility requirements:

- Organization must be a not-for-profit organization whose service area includes Ottawa County.
- Organization must not discriminate on the basis of age, race, gender, faith or religion, sexual preference or orientation, or physical or mental disability.
- Within one year of receiving the award, recipients must provide LAADSV with a written report detailing the number of people served/reached and the impact/results of the program or activity funded under the grant.
- Award must be used for programs/services provided in Ottawa County.

LAADSV will not award funds to:

- Individuals
- For-profit organizations
- Organizations that directly or indirectly participate in, or intervene in, any political campaign on behalf of (or in opposition to) any candidate for elective public office.
- Organizations that contribute to campaign funds or make public statements in support of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.
- Organizations that do not support diversity, equity, and inclusion or the rights of all victims of domestic and sexual violence.

To be considered for Power of Prevention funds, organizations must submit a completed application by 5:00pm on **AUGUST 12, 2024**. Awards will be presented at the Together We Can Appreciation Awards on October 16, 2024 at Macatawa Golf Club RedRock Grille.
